

Economic Impacts (2014)

Agricultural and related industries generate

8,638 jobs (16.8% of total) in Citrus County.

\$339.4 million in revenues.

8.8% contribution to gross regional product.

Based on an annual UF study, it is estimated that for every **\$1** invested in agricultural research and Extension, there is a return of **\$20** to the community.
