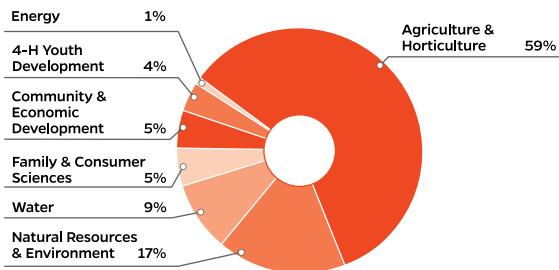
In 2023, of participants surveyed,

- 24% conserved more water or energy

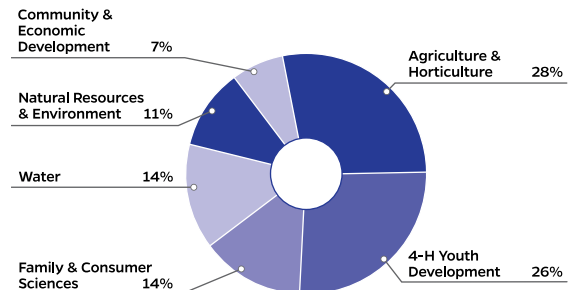
STATE FACULTY BY PROGRAM AREA

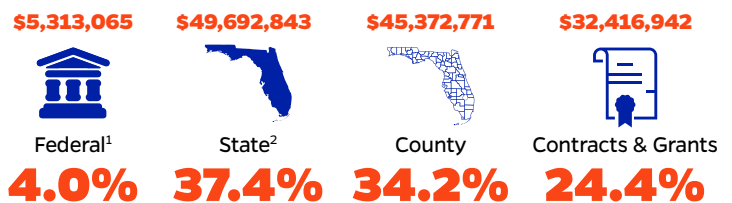
