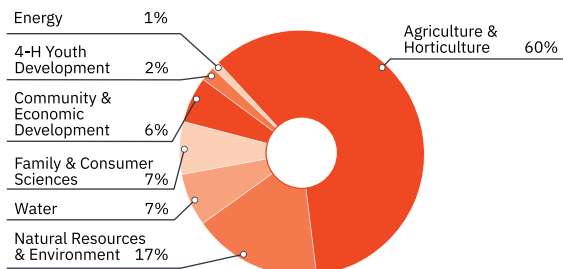

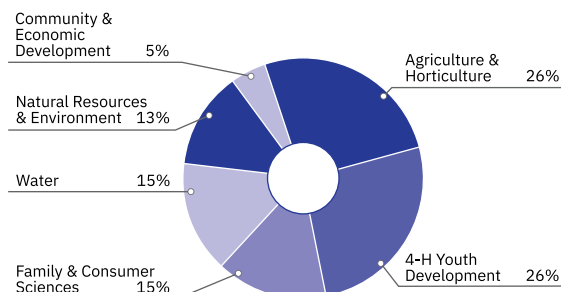
STATE FACULTY BY PROGRAM AREA
