

## UF/IFAS Extension FNP/EFNEP Coronavirus Response Plan 2020

### Our Commitment:

- UF/IFAS Extension FNP/EFNEP will base all decisions on science-based information and resources from University of Florida experts, Florida Department of Health, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and other state and federal public health agencies with the goal being to minimize the spread of coronavirus while mitigating the disruptive impact to our clients, stakeholders, partners, families, volunteers, staff, and faculty. We will be in line with University of Florida guidance on this issue.

### Effective **IMMEDIATELY** and through April 30, 2020, the following temporary regulations will govern UF/IFAS Extension FNP/EFNEP programs:

- In-person programming organized or led by UF/IFAS Extension FNP/EFNEP are cancelled. This extends to all nutrition education classes (series-based or one-time), workshops, demos, camps, conferences, retreats, etc.
- Continue to follow county guidelines or extension office closures. In the meantime, please plan on reporting to work. If you have special circumstances that require you to work from home, please discuss with your supervisor as you will need prior approval. This process requires an approval of an Alternate Work Location form and must be filed with main campus.
- No UF/IFAS Extension FNP/EFNEP sponsored out-of-state travel for faculty or staff. No out-of-county travel unless authorized by supervisor.
